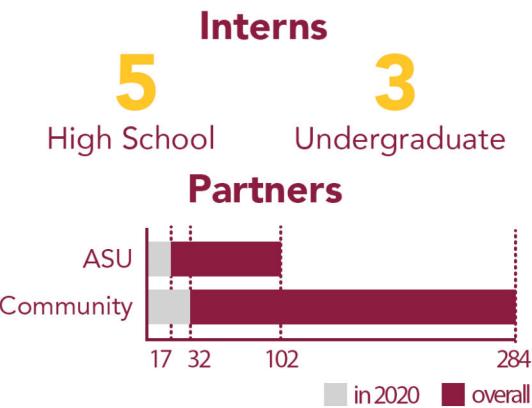

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Hacks for Humanity:

Because of Covid-19 challenges and uncertainties, our seventh annual Hacks for Humanity: Hacking for the Social Good pivoted to a virtual, global format. This event drew participants from different professions, ages, communities, backgrounds, and places — ranging across 4 states and 14 countries. Participants were put into randomly assembled teams, and over the course of 3 days collaborated to create solutions to big social challenges.

Podcast Club Series:

Talking, Listening and Podcasting with ASU Project Humanities launched as a new program series this summer. The podcast club invites individuals to listen to a pre-selected podcast independently, then come together to talk and learn about it during an hour-long virtual discussion.

Homeless Outreach:
